
The Selkirk Peer Advisory group is a group of people who use drugs and provide advice on how to make harm reduction and services better.

Harm Reduction Saves Lives! Harm reduction isn't just about needles. Harm reduction meets people where they're at and supports relationship and community building. It connects people with services to support their health and wellbeing, whether it's getting a family doctor, prenatal care, STBBI testing, addictions treatment, or mental health support. Harm reduction supports people who use drugs in being healthy and staying healthy. It empowers people with the knowledge and tools to make safer choices and prevent HIV, hepatitis, infection, injury, vein damage, and overdose.

Pick up your SUPPLIES

Pick up: Needles, cookers, sterile water, ties, alcohol swabs, bandaids, filters, sharps containers, condoms, gloves, lube, information.

Have an abscess, infection, STI or health concern? Ask to see a nurse.
